### *MONTHLY REPORT FOR MAY 2012*

#### POLICE ACTIVITY:

- The department handled 1305 law incidents for the month, issued 110 infractions, 25 criminal traffic citations, 23 criminal citations, 7 parking infractions and made 104 criminal arrests.
- During the month, Animal Control Officer Bob Hill handled 75 "animal problem" complaints, 19 abandoned vehicles, 2 code enforcement issue and 5 parking complaints. A total of 29 animals were impounded.
- WEEKEND JAIL SESSION #5: On May 5<sup>th</sup>, the department opened the jail for the fifth planned warrant sweep/jail session. During the open jail, 22 people were arrested and booked into the jail on a combination of warrants, commitments and new charges. Two prisoners posted a total of \$1,800 to secure their release pending their next court appearance. Three people were booked into jail to serve time on court ordered commitments. During court on May 8<sup>th</sup>, five people walked into court to surrender themselves on outstanding warrants. A total of 29 warrants were cleared during this session.
- On **05-08-12** at about 2330 hours members of the department traffic collision/crime scene team responded to Ocean shores at the request of OSPD to assist in a fatal traffic collision investigation. The department members are specially trained in crime and traffic scene investigation using forensic mapping equipment.
- On **05-10-12** at about 1530 hours, a 45-year old Westport woman went to the Social Security office. When she arrived, it is protocol for the Federal Security Officer to search bags people are carrying into the office area. When the woman's purse was searched heroin was found and Hoquiam Officers were called. The woman's information was checked through dispatch and it was found she had three felony warrants for her arrest. The woman was booked into the county jail for warrants and faces new charges for possession of heroin.
- On **05-12-12** at about 0617 hours, a Hoquiam resident in the 100 block of Emerson called 911 to report a trespass at his residence. Officers arrived and learned the man woke up and found an acquaintance of his in the kitchen cooking something. It was unknown how the suspect gained entry to the house. The man asked the 22-year old Hoquiam transient what he was doing in his house. The suspect threatened to assault him before going out the back door. A search was conducted for the suspect who is well known to officers. The charge of trespass has been filed with the City Prosecutor.
- On **05-13-12** at about 0740 hours, a Hoquiam woman was waiting for a bus at the transit station at 7<sup>th</sup> and J Streets when she was approached by a white male she did not know. The male had asked the woman for some change which she gave him. The male then grabbed the woman's wallet and ran off. A description of the suspect was obtained and a search was conducted with negative results. At this time the suspect is unidentified.
- On **05-15-12** at about 1000 hours, a 48-year old Hoquiam man was arrested for Domestic Violence Assault 4<sup>th</sup> Degree after allegedly assaulting his female roommate. The Hoquiam

Municipal Court was in session and the man was taken before the judge. The man continually argued with the Judge and was subsequently sent to the Forks jail to await his next court date.

- On **05-16-12** at about 1300 hours, Hoquiam Officers responded to a report of a theft of medication from a doctor's office in the 800 block of K Street. During the investigation employees of the office said they had seen a 30-year old Cosmopolis man coming out of the open medication room in the facility. The man had been in the office for an appointment and was supposed to be in an examination room. When employees confronted the man he seemed startled and walked directly into the bathroom where he stayed for several minutes. The man then left the building and employees checked the bathroom and discovered a concealed empty box of "Lidocaine" in the bathroom garbage can. Information was obtained on the suspect and officers went to his Cosmopolis address and confronted the man. The man readily admitted to taking the drugs and retrieved them from his house. He has been charged with theft.
- On **05-29-12** at about 2030 hours, Officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of Sumner Avenue for a Domestic Assault complaint. It was discovered during a dispute between male and female roommates, a 33-year old Hoquiam woman had slapped her roommate across the face. The woman was arrested for Assault 4<sup>th</sup> degree and booked in the county jail. The next day the woman was released from jail with a court order to not go back to the residence. Upon release the woman went back to the residence and immediately started a verbal argument. The woman was arrested again and booked back into the county jail to await her next court date.
- During the month of May, utilizing the day inmates serving court ordered sentences, maintenance projects were completed around the city. The "Welcome to Hoquiam" signs on Perry Avenue and Emerson Avenue were cleaned with the landscaping all redone.

#### BUDGET:

- For the month of May, **341 hours** of overtime was expended for patrol as listed below:

- The outside placement of prisoners and fuel costs are still a great concern for the department which is being closely monitored each month by Chief Myers. With the possibility of the Municipal agencies having to pay medical bills incurred by arrestees housed at the Grays Harbor County jail as proposed by the county. The department will have to monitor the monthly jail expenditures even more closely as this could drain the department's funds quickly with only a few extreme unexpected medical bills.

#### PERSONNEL:

May was a very busy month for training officers at the department to enhance their skills or to

train in new areas to build their expertise within the department.

- Officer Blodgett attended Master Defensive Tactics Re-certification at CJTC and also attended a 40-hour course to be a certified Field Training Officer.
- Officer McCartney also attended the 40-hour Field Training Officer course.
- Officer Luce attended the Northwest Gang conference in Spokane. Officer Luce is the department Gang Liaison Officer and this conference gave him the opportunity to network with other gang officers in the state and Idaho on gang activity in the region.
- Officer High attended a 120-hour Technical Collision Investigation course at the WSP academy. Officer High is a member of the department collision investigation team which helps to investigate serious crime and accident scenes utilizing the total station survey measurement device.
- Sgt. Salstrom and Officer Peterson attended the annual Tactical K-9 training in session near Port Angeles.
- Department members completed pistol and patrol rifle qualifications this month.
- Sgt. Krohn attended a two-day Public Safety Media training course in Burien and also attended a re-certification for child victim forensic interviews.
- Det. Blundred attended a 40-hour Homicide Investigation school in Burien.
- DC Wertanen attended a 32-hour course on vehicle fires at the annual NW Fire Investigators conference.
- Officer Dayton gave a talk on honesty to the students at Lincoln School which was very well received.
- Sgt. Krohn and Officer Blodgett attended a 1-day seminar on Officer Killed or Assaulted in Centralia.
- Three department members celebrated anniversaries this month. Sergeant Salstrom and Sergeant Mitchell have been with the department for 11 years and our own leader Chief Myers has been with us for 6 years. Congratulations and thank-you all for what you do for the city and department.

#### FACILITIES/EQUIPMENT:

- The department purchased yard maintenance tools and supplies which were used by Day Inmates for projects around the city and the department.
- The department purchased a supply of ammunition for all department weapons for \$4,032. This was done during the month of May as there was a pending price increase set for June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Our officers, along with the assistance from IT technician Bobby Jackson, installed a new digital bulletin board in the communication center and moved the old one into the department lobby. The bulletin board in the lobby has a welcome message and information of interest to the public. The information on the board also includes flyers on all Level III sex offenders registered within the city.
- The department purchased a second network switch for \$2,284 to facilitate the future addition of the IP security cameras and IP phone system. The 48-port switch was needed as each camera and phone must be connected back into the city server.

#### VOLUNTEERS:

- For the month of May, CRIME WATCH members volunteered a total of **129** hours of service, which included 114.25 hours in residence and business checks.
- For the month of May, the Hoquiam Police Explorer Post logged a total of **37** hours. The hours were logged mainly as ride along with officers and meetings.

The following statistical reports encompass police activity for the month. The first statistical report titled "Law Incident Analysis, Time Reported" is a summary of each law incident by the day of the week and by the time of day.


The second statistical report is a listing of "Law Total Incident Report, by Location Code". The three general areas of the city are designated by location codes: HPD Baker 6 is defined as the east end, HPD Baker 7 is the downtown area and west to the high school, and HPD Baker 8 is the north end of town from Emerson Avenue. Any location codes that are outside of the city were likely generated as a result of phone call requests to the station, traffic safety patrols or agency assists.

The third statistical report, "Total Law Incident Report, by Nature of Incident" shows the total for each of the basic law incident types handled by the department.

The final two monthly reports included in this packet are "Total Traffic Citation Report, by Violation" and "Total Offense Report, By Statute Description". The first report lists the specific infraction or criminal charge and the number of violations issued under that charge. The second report is reflective of the number of "arrests" made under each statute. The two reports may overlap on some misdemeanor offenses if an arrest/booking was made followed by the issuance of a criminal citation. The second report captures felony arrests, but may not include misdemeanor or felony cases that were submitted to the prosecutor for review of charges (cases cleared without an arrest).
