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## *MONTHLY REPORT FOR NOVEMBER 2012*

### POLICE ACTIVITY:

- The department handled 1141 law incidents for the month, issued 66 infractions, 21 criminal traffic citations, 26 criminal citations, 8 parking infractions and made 160 criminal arrests.
- During the month, Animal Control Officer Bob Hill handled 70 “animal problem” complaints, 15 abandoned vehicles, 4 code enforcement issues and 8 parking complaints. 23 animals were impounded.
- There was no open jail for the month of November. There is a jail opening set for December 8<sup>th</sup>, which was planned to end on the 11<sup>th</sup>. We are attempting to expand this opening to a two-week session to include DOC offenders.
- **On 11-01-12** about 1258 hours, officers and aid personnel were dispatched to a vehicle collision in the 3100 block of Sumner Avenue. It was reported a red Nissan pick up had hit a parked vehicle then ran into a tree. Witnesses stated they saw the vehicle traveling west bound on Sumner Avenue erratically. The vehicle accelerated rapidly then striking a parked vehicle on the north side of the street and then came to rest against a large tree. The driver, a 66-year old Hoquiam woman admitting to have taken prescription narcotics before driving. HFD treated the woman on scene and later transported her to the hospital for possible injuries. Charges of DUI will be submitted to the City Prosecutor for review. Both vehicles were a total loss.
- **On 11-12-12** at about 1851 hours, officers responded to the 3100 block of Sumner Avenue for a report of a suspicious circumstance. The son of the residents had reported, he arrived home to find his father lying on top of his mother in a pool of blood. Knives were scattered about. HPD and HFD arrived on scene and it was determined both parties were deceased. The scene was secured and an investigation was conducted. It was determined both parties had sustained knife wounds contributing to their deaths. There was no evidence to indicate this incident involved any persons outside the residence. An autopsy clearly showed the 48-year old Hoquiam woman died by homicide and the 53-year old Hoquiam man died by suicide. The couple had been married and going through domestic issues over an incident alleging a sex crime 10-12 years before.
- **On 11-20-12** at about 1523 hours, while on patrol Officer Blodgett saw a male subject riding a bicycle who had a DOC warrant for his arrest. The subject saw Officer Blodgett, ditched his bike and fled on foot in the 800 block of Lincoln Street. Officers responded to attempt to locate the subject. Another officer saw a male jumping into a white van across from where the officers were looking. The van was last seen heading north through alleys. The van was located in the 400 block of Perry and through the investigation it was determined this was not the subject Officer Blodgett had seen earlier. However, a warrants check revealed he had a DOC warrant for his arrest. Once the 20-year old Hoquiam man heard this, he tried to flee and

fought with officers attempting to arrest him. The man was booked into the county jail for Assault 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, Resisting Arrest and the DOC warrant. The first man was not located.

- **On 11-20-12** at about 1620 hours, a bank Robbery had occurred in Elma, it was also determined the male suspect had fled before police arrived. Det. Sgt. Krohn and Det. Blundred responded to assist with the investigation. The following week two suspects were arrested in Mason County for the robbery.
- **On 11-25-12** at about 2123 hours, officers responded to a residence in the 200 block of 4<sup>th</sup> Street for a report of a trespass. Officers spoke to the homeowners, who stated they had arrived at their rental house and discovered someone had entered while they were away. A man and woman were found hiding in a closet by the owners. Once discovered, they fled out of the house. With the description given to the officers and evidence located at the scene, it was determined the suspects involved are well known to officers from previous law enforcement contacts. The 21-year old Hoquiam man and 21-year old Hoquiam woman were located and later identified by the victims. The two suspects were booked into the county jail for Trespass 1<sup>st</sup> Degree.
- **On 11-26-12** at about 1523 hours, officers responded to the 300 block of O Street for a report of a Burglary in progress. The residence had recently been condemned by the city, and posted "Unfit" to Occupy. Officers searched and found three males inside. One suspect fled out the back door. An officer located the suspect running a short distance away and attempted to take custody of him. After a short struggle, the 38-year old Hoquiam man was taken into custody and booked into the county jail for Trespass 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree and Resisting Arrest. The other two males were released as it was determined they had been brought to the residence by the suspect under false pretenses.
- **On 11-27-12** at about 1032 hours, officers were dispatched to the 2900 block of Sumner Avenue reference a two-vehicle injury accident. The investigation revealed a silver mustang, driven by a 50-year old Hoquiam woman was traveling westbound in the left lane. The woman said her walking cast caught under the gas pedal and she lost control of the car. Her vehicle struck a parked unoccupied vehicle. HFD transported the woman for possible neck and back injuries.
- **Since July**, the department has been investigating a Home Invasion Burglary, which occurred in the 400 block of Karr Avenue. Investigators were waiting on DNA samples sent to the state crime lab to confirm the involvement of a 34-year old Kelso man. Confirmation on the DNA match resulted in the Grays Harbor Superior Court issuing a \$500,000 warrant for his arrest. **On 11-29-12** at about 1046 hours, Det. Sgt. Krohn and Det. Blundred traveled to Kelso on a tip, and located the suspect and took him into custody with the assistance of Kelso Police. The man booked at the Grays Harbor County Jail. Later in the day the victim of the original case, a 21-year old Hoquiam woman, was arrested on a felony warrant for her for Vehicular Homicide in an Ocean Shores case which prompted the Home Invasion case here.

PERSONNEL:

- There are two anniversaries this month, Sgt. Strong has been with the department for 18 years and Det. Blundred has been with us for 3 years. Congratulations to both and thank you for your dedication and for the outstanding job.
- Officer High became certified as a Marijuana Leaf Technician through the Washington State Crime Lab.
- Chief Myers and DC Wertanen attended the annual fall WASPC conference in Chelan. Topics covered during the conference were legal and legislative updates for law enforcement.

FACILITIES/EQUIPMENT:

- On November 26<sup>th</sup>, the City Council approved the purchase of a new patrol vehicle for the department. A 2013 Dodge Durango has been ordered to replace a 2007 Ford Crown Victoria, which has suffered a blown transmission and was taken out-of-service.

VOLUNTEERS:

- For the month, CRIME WATCH members volunteered a total of 135 hours of service, which included residence and business checks.
- For the month, the Hoquiam Police Explorer Post logged a total of 126.5 hours, which was a combination of patrolling with officers and meetings.
- At the November 26<sup>th</sup> council meeting, Keaton Bradley received recognition for his service to the department Explorer program and all the time he had volunteered in updating the department computer and camera systems. Keaton had been with the Hoquiam Explorer Program since its start and now that he has turned 21-years of age, he is no longer eligible for the program. Keaton's service and dedication to the Explorer program and department is greatly appreciated.

STATISTICAL REPORTS:

The following statistical reports encompass police activity for the month. The first statistical report titled "Law Incident Analysis, Time Reported" is a summary of each law incident by the day of the week and by the time of day.

The second statistical report is a listing of "Law Total Incident Report, by Location Code". The three general areas of the city are designated by location codes: HPD Baker 6 is defined as the east end, HPD Baker 7 is the downtown area and west to the high school, and HPD Baker 8 is the north end of town from Emerson Avenue. Any location codes that are outside of the city were likely generated as a result of phone call requests to the station, traffic safety patrols or agency assists.


The third statistical report, "Total Law Incident Report, by Nature of Incident" shows the total for each of the basic law incident types handled by the department.

The final two monthly reports included in this packet are "Total Traffic Citation Report, by Violation" and "Total Offense Report, By Statute Description". The first report lists the specific infraction or criminal charge and the number of violations issued under that charge. The second report is reflective of the number of "arrests" made under each statute. The two reports may overlap on some

misdemeanor offenses if an arrest/booking was made followed by the issuance of a criminal citation. The second report captures felony arrests, but may not include misdemeanor or felony cases that were submitted to the prosecutor for review of charges (cases cleared without an arrest).
