## *MONTHLY REPORT for August 2013*

### POLICE ACTIVITY:

- The department handled 1517 law incidents for the month, issued 82 infractions, 29 criminal traffic citations, 26 criminal citations, 11 parking infractions and made 140 criminal arrests.
- During the month, Animal Control Officer Bob Hill handled 99 “animal problem” complaints, 15 abandoned vehicles, and 50 parking complaints; 31 animals were impounded.
- **On 08-22-13** at about 0700 hours, Hoquiam Officers assisted the Grays Harbor Drug Task Force in serving two search warrants in Hoquiam and Aberdeen. These two locations had been under investigation for some time for the distribution of heroin in the area. In serving the warrants; five males ranging in ages from 32 to 59-years old and three females ranging from 19 to 27-years old were taken into custody for drug violations and/or warrants. The suspects were residents of Aberdeen and Hoquiam.
- **On 08-25-13** at 2134 hours, officers went to a residence in the 2400 block of Simpson Avenue to try and locate a male suspect for the Aberdeen Police. Officers arrived, entered an open garage and found a male trying to hide by pressing himself against the wall in the darkness as he held a police scanner. The suspect, a 39-year old Aberdeen man, who is well known to officers, had a valid DOC warrant and was arrested. The suspect was also in possession of heroin, methamphetamine and cocaine. The man was booked into the Hoquiam Jail on the warrant and will be charged on the drug charges once the crime lab positively identifies the drugs.
- **On 08-26-13** at about 1200 hours, Detective Blundred received information from Butcher’s Scrap Metal of possible stolen metal. Det. Blundred investigated the information and developed two suspects, a 51-year old woman and a 35-year old man both of Hoquiam. Det. Blundred continued his investigation and discovered some of the metal stolen was from an undeveloped trailer park on Broadway Avenue. Through the investigation Det. Blundred was able to link the two suspects to four active metal theft cases. The male was arrested for Theft in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree and two-counts of Trafficking Stolen Property 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree; he was booked into the county jail. The female will be charged with Trafficking Stolen Property 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree. It should be noted Butcher’s Scrap Metal has been working very closely with the department in identifying suspected stolen metal.
- **On 08-27-13** at about 1300 hours, officers responded to a vehicle versus pedestrian accident at 29<sup>th</sup> Street at Simpson Avenue. A 29-year old Aberdeen woman was starting to cross 29<sup>th</sup> on Simpson Avenue and was struck by a 19-year old Hoquiam woman who was turning onto Simpson from 29<sup>th</sup> Street. The driver of the vehicle stated she had checked for traffic to the left but did not look back to the right before turning. The victim sustained a cut to the chin and was transported to the hospital by HFD. The driver was issued an infraction for failing to yield to a pedestrian.

## PERSONNEL:

- All department personnel attended rifle and back-up weapons certification this month. The training was held on two separate days so both patrol teams and the Police Services Officers could attend. The training was conducted by Sgt. Krohn and Deputy Chief Layman of the Cosmopolis Police Department; both are certified Firearms Instructors.
- Officer High had been appointed to be the Accreditation Manager for the department. He has been working extra hours to assure all areas of the on-site evaluation are met. This is a tedious and time consuming job, which he has working very hard on in the preparation for our September 30<sup>th</sup> evaluation.
- Chief Myers, Sgt. Dayton and Officer McCartney participated in the Target Zero Traffic DUI Emphasis this month. Officers from area agencies participate in these programs and work throughout the county to enforce the DUI and traffic laws.
- Chief Myers and several sergeants attended a 4-hour training session held by BNSF and PSP railways. The training was centered on responding to railroad emergencies and hazards. The training was held at the Rotary Log Pavilion in Aberdeen.
- Sgt. Krohn, Det. Blundred and PSO Boggs attended an 8-hour training session in Kelso for Public Disclosure for Law Enforcement.
- Department members completed Work Place Harassment training this month. Department members reviewed policies and watched a training video on the subject.
- Officers, Crime Watch Volunteers and the Police Explorers participated in this year's National Night Out on August 6<sup>th</sup>. The members went around town and visited the nine neighborhood parties and met with community members during the evening.
- Anniversaries this month included A.A. Candi Wertanen at 27 years with the department and Officer Gary Bryant with 12 years. Both are valued employees and great assets to the department and city.

## FACILITY:

- The jail laundry is finally up and running with the new commercial washer and dual gas dryer.
- New electrical plug-ins were added by the city electrician in the sally port at the department. These were necessary for the extra freezers for the jail food as well as lighting to process evidence in vehicles held on search warrants.

#### VOLUNTEERS:

- For the month, CRIME WATCH members volunteered a total of **129.5** hours of service, which included residence and business checks. A special thank you to Crime Watch Volunteer Karen Harp. Karen put in a lot of work in preparing for National Night Out by making prize boxes for the neighborhood parties with donated items from local businesses.
- For the month, the Hoquiam Police Explorer Post logged a total of **103.5** hours, which was a combination of patrolling with officers and meetings.

#### STATISTICAL REPORTS:

The following statistical reports encompass police activity for the month. The first statistical report titled “Law Incident Analysis, Time Reported” is a summary of each law incident by the day of the week and by the time of day.

The second statistical report is a listing of “Law Total Incident Report, by Location Code”. The three general areas of the city are designated by location codes: HPD Baker 6 is defined as the east end, HPD Baker 7 is the downtown area and west to the high school, and HPD Baker 8 is the north end of town from Emerson Avenue. Any location codes that are outside of the city were likely generated as a result of phone call requests to the station, traffic safety patrols or agency assists.

The third statistical report, “Total Law Incident Report, by Nature of Incident” shows the total for each of the basic law incident types handled by the department.

The final two monthly reports included in this packet are “Total Traffic Citation Report, by Violation” and “Total Offense Report, By Statute Description”. The first report lists the specific infraction or criminal charge and the number of violations issued under that charge. The second report is reflective of the number of “arrests” made under each statute. The two reports may overlap on some misdemeanor offenses if an arrest/booking was made followed by the issuance of a criminal citation. The second report captures felony arrests, but may not include misdemeanor or felony cases which were submitted to the prosecutor for review of charges (cases cleared without an arrest).
