MONTHLY REPORT for February 2013

POLICE ACTIVITY:

- The department handled 1257 law incidents for the month, issued 77 infractions, 34 criminal traffic citations, 26 criminal citations, 11 parking infractions and made 113 criminal arrests.
- During the month, Animal Control Officer Bob Hill handled 83 “animal problem” complaints, 30 abandoned vehicles, 6 code enforcement issues and 16 parking complaints; 22 animals were impounded.
- **On January 25th**, the jail opened for a 19-day session as a warrant sweep and to hold DOC offenders. The jail stayed open until the end of court on February 12th. A total of 86 people were booked into the jail on a combination of HMC warrants, DOC holds and new offenses. At the end of the jail opening, one female and five males were transported to the Forks jail to be held on future pre-trial hearings. DOC offenders still having time to serve were moved to other contract facilities. A total of 44 DOC offenders were held during the session; the department billed DOC \$15,680 for housing the offenders. The department is hoping to open the jail full time on April 1, 2013.
- **On 02-16-13**, officers responded to the 200 block of 4th Street in Hoquiam for a reported Robbery. A 19-year old Hoquiam man said he had been in the parking garage playing a video game on his computer. The victim said a male unknown to him came in the garage and attempted to take the computer from him. A short struggle occurred between the two. The victim said the male suspect allegedly pulled a knife, and then fled. The victim was able to give a description of the suspect, which was similar to a subject well known by officers. During the search of the area the suspect, a 22-year old Hoquiam transient, was located and identified by the victim. When the suspect was contacted by the officers he attempted to run. The suspect was booked into the county jail for Robbery.
- **On 02-16-13**, at about 0415 hours, officers on patrol near 31st Street contacted two subjects and identified them. One of the subjects gave a name which was known to be an alias to the officers. A warrants check was conducted and it was found the subject had several warrants for his arrest including a felony warrant for fail to register as a sex offender. The 23-year old Aberdeen man tried to push past the officers and run. Officers ordered the subject to stop or he would be tased. The subject immediately gave up and was booked for Resisting Arrest and outstanding warrants.
- **On 02-19-13**, officers responded to a business in the 200 block of K Street for a report of a shoplifting incident. During the investigation the clerk told officers a female came in the store and ran out with four cans of beer. The clerk chased and caught up to the female a short distance from the store. The clerk grabbed the suspect, an 18-year old Aberdeen woman. The female bit the clerk’s hand. The female immediately ran away. Officers received a witness report of the possible location of the female in the 300 block of 3rd Street. The resident confirmed the female had been in the house but had left through the back door just before

police arrived. Officers located an address for the female in Aberdeen and booked her for Robbery.

- **On 02-22-13** at about 1630 hours, officers with HFD paramedics were dispatched to the 800 block of Hill Avenue for a report of a drug overdose. A 28-year old Hoquiam man was found in the residence unresponsive due to heroin. The male was treated by paramedics and transported to the hospital. Several other subjects in the house (all self-admitted heroin abusers) said they had bought the drugs in Aberdeen. There had been another overdose at the residence the day before. The house is known for other suspected criminal activity and domestic issues. A report will be forwarded to the city code enforcement officer for investi as a chronic nuisance.
- **On 02-23-13**, at about 1723 hour Sgt. Mitchell was on patrol on Grant Avenue and saw a vehicle with scrap metal inside and on the roof. In the driveway of a vacant residence. Sgt. Mitchell stopped to investigate and was told by a neighbor someone was stealing items from the residence. The driver of the car, a 44-year old Hoquiam man, exited the garage, saw Sgt. Mitchell and attempted to drive away. Sgt. Mitchell stopped the subject t and the suspect immediately lowered his head and said he was "in trouble". He admitted to stealing the items from the vacant house. The man was booked for Criminal Trespass, Theft 3rd and Driving While Suspended into the county jail.
- **On 02-26-12** at about 0150 hours, Sgt. Dayton stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation. During the contact it was found the 39-year old Aberdeen woman's driver's license was suspended and she was taken into custody. There were two male passengers were told they could leave as the vehicle was going to be impounded. During the inventory of the vehicle a glasses case was found on the backseat, which was found to contain suspected methamphetamine. Also under the seat was a locked gray box; the female denied any knowledge of the box or its contents. Sgt. Dayton talked to the vehicle owner on the phone and she too denied any knowledge of the box. Since no one claimed ownership of the locked box it was seized as found property and brought to HPD. The box was opened and several bags of suspected narcotics were found. While booking the driver, she was found to be in possession of \$1,400 in counterfeit currency. The woman was cited for Driving While Suspended. The counterfeit money will be sent to the Secret Service.

BUDGET:

PERSONNEL:

- PSO Hill hosted the annual Rabies/Licensing Clinic at the department on February 23rd. Veterinarian Dave Westby provided his services for the rabies clinic.

- Sgt. Krohn gave an Anti-Bullying speech at the Hoquiam Middle school to the student body during an assembly. There were several guest speakers who shared their experiences from being bullied or being a bully.
- Department members were re-certified in the use of impact weapons (collapsible batons) during defensive tactics training held in the department training room. The training was held on two different days so both patrol teams could attend.
- Police Services Officers Noffsinger and Spaur started the Corrections Officer Academy at the Criminal Justice Training Center on February 15th. Both are doing well with their training and are expected to graduate on March 15th.
- All of the Sergeants have met the state requirements and have received their First Level Supervision career certification from CJTC.
- Officer Figg attended a one-day advanced interview and interrogation course held at the Criminal Justice Training Center.
- Officer High celebrates 3-years with the department as of February 1, 2013.

VOLUNTEERS:

- For the month, CRIME WATCH members volunteered a total of 116.5 hours of service, which included residence and business checks. Crime Watch members also assisted with the Rabies/Licensing Clinic.
- For the month, the Hoquiam Police Explorer Post logged a total of 152 hours, which was a combination of patrolling with officers and meetings.

STATISTICAL REPORTS:

The following statistical reports encompass police activity for the month. The first statistical report titled "Law Incident Analysis, Time Reported" is a summary of each law incident by the day of the week and by the time of day.

The second statistical report is a listing of "Law Total Incident Report, by Location Code". The three general areas of the city are designated by location codes: HPD Baker 6 is defined as the east end, HPD Baker 7 is the downtown area and west to the high school, and HPD Baker 8 is the north end of town from Emerson Avenue. Any location codes that are outside of the city were likely generated as a result of phone call requests to the station, traffic safety patrols or agency assists.

The third statistical report, "Total Law Incident Report, by Nature of Incident" shows the total for each of the basic law incident types handled by the department.

The final two monthly reports included in this packet are "Total Traffic Citation Report, by Violation" and "Total Offense Report, By Statute Description". The first report lists the specific infraction or criminal charge and the number of violations issued under that charge. The second report is reflective of the number of "arrests" made under each statute. The two reports may overlap on some misdemeanor offenses if an arrest/booking was made followed by the issuance of a criminal citation. The second report captures felony arrests, but may not include misdemeanor or felony cases that were submitted to the prosecutor for review of charges (cases cleared without an arrest).
