MONTHLY REPORT FOR January 2013

POLICE ACTIVITY:

- The department handled 1262 law incidents for the month, issued 74 infractions, 36 criminal traffic citations, 17 criminal citations, 30 parking infractions and made 108 criminal arrests.
- During the month, Animal Control Officer Bob Hill handled 69 “animal problem” complaints, 46 abandoned vehicles, 11 code enforcement issues and 30 parking complaints; 31 animals were impounded.
- **On 01-20-13** at about 0149 hours, Officer McCartney was on patrol in the 2500 block of Simpson Avenue and saw a male subject jump a fence between two houses and cross Simpson Avenue. Officer McCartney contacted the 49-year old Aberdeen man, who was shaking, denied he had climbed over a fence and acted as if he didn’t know what the officer was talking about. The male was identified and arrested on an outstanding Hoquiam warrant. Officer McCartney saw the male struggling in the back of the patrol car when they at the city jail. Officer McCartney discovered the male had tried to hide a bag of suspected methamphetamine patrol car. The male was booked into the Hoquiam jail for the warrant and charges will be filed for felony drug charge.
- **On 01-27-13** at about 1522 hours, Sgt. Dayton attempted to stop a red Honda in the 2500 block of Simpson Avenue for a traffic violation. As soon as Sgt. Dayton activated his emergency lights, the driver accelerated to an estimated 60 M.P.H. heading eastbound on Simpson Avenue. The driver attempted to elude Sgt. Dayton by traveling down alleys, side streets and sidewalks. Aberdeen police set up spike strips to stop the vehicle but the driver avoided them. The chase continued through Aberdeen then headed back to Hoquiam. The driver abandoned the vehicle in the 2000 block of Port Industrial Road. Witnesses called dispatch with directions of the suspect. The suspect, a 23-year old Hoquiam man, was found hiding behind a house and taken into custody for Felony Eluding and a DOC warrant. The vehicle he had been driving was towed to HPD for processing. It was later determined the vehicle was an unreported stolen vehicle. The vehicle was searched, narcotics believed to belong to the suspect were seized.
- **On 01-29-13** at about 1143 hours, officers were dispatched to a vacant residence in the 300 block of Karr Avenue for a possible burglary in progress. A 44-year old Hoquiam man was found hiding in the garage. The investigation revealed the suspect had gained entry through a crawl space under the house. It was also discovered he had a bucket of freshly cut pipe and wiring and burglary tools. The suspect interviewed. He said he was looking for a place to sleep; he claimed he did not know anything about the wire. The suspect was booked into jail for burglary.
- **On 01-29-13** at about 2039 hours, officers were in the area between Simpson and Sumner Avenues as there had been reports of theft of copper wire from telephone poles in the area. Officers spotted a subject wearing a backpack in a dark alley in the 2400 block. When contacted the male said he wasn’t doing anything to the power poles, which had not been

mentioned by the officers. The officers asked for identification and the subject said he did not have any, at which time he verbally gave his name. There was no computer. When pressed about his name, it was determined the 26-year old Copalis Beach man had a felony warrant for his arrest through Grays Harbor County. The subject was searched and found to be in possession of suspected methamphetamine, several items associated with selling narcotics and \$460 in cash. The subject was interviewed about the suspected drugs and cash. He admitted he does not work and sells drugs to support his own habit and pay for motel rooms. The man was booked into the county jail on the felony warrant. The man also faces new drug charges.

- **On 01-29-13** at about 2048 hours, officers responded to the storage units in the 500 block of Bayview for a burglary complaint. The renter of the storage unit had received a call from the business owner stating he suspected the lock being cut off a rented unit. The renter discovered several items had been stolen from the unit including, TV's, tools, surround sound system and furniture. The total dollar amount was valued at thousands of dollars. At this time, there are no suspects. There have been several burglaries reported from these units since August 2012. This case and others are still under investigation.
- **On 01-31-12** at about 1135 hours, officers went to a residence in the 600 block of Karr Avenue to serve a subject with a Hoquiam Municipal Court No-Contact Order. When officers arrived, they saw a dog tied up in the front yard and could see the dog was trying to break free. Within moments, the dog did break free and ran towards the back of the house. The front door of the house opened and out walked a 27-year old Hoquiam man, who officers new was restrained from being at the residence. Officers asked what he was doing there. The man turned to his friend and said, "I'm going to jail". The man was arrested without incident and booked into the Hoquiam Jail. The original subject the officers were going to serve the order on was not located.

BUDGET:

- For the month, **172 hours** of overtime was expended for patrol as listed below:

PERSONNEL:

- Officer Hergert attended a 40-hour Pre-Supervisor training at the CJTC. All officers assigned to be an Officer In-Charge in the absence of the sergeant require this training by our department.
- Det. Blundred completed on-line training from Learning for Life, which is the website for Police Explorer Posts. Det. Blundred is the department liaison officer for our explorer post. The training included safety on ride-alongs, youth safety and weather hazards.
- The department administrators and sergeants attended WCIA training held at CJTC, which covered the topics of Supervision and Personnel Issues.
- Officers from the Hoquiam Police Department along with 62 officers from many area agencies attended Rapid Intervention Training conducted by the Seattle Police Department Advanced

Unit. The training was held at sites in Ocean Shores and Hoquiam. The officers were trained on response and tactics to an active shooter situation. Officers were given several scenarios where a shooter was holding hostages. The officers were trained on how to respond to the situations and resolve them. This training is very important with the increased incidents of mass shooting through out the country. Public school and fire officials also attended and participated in some excercises.

- Five officers celebrated anniversaries with the department in January. DC Wertanen 26-years, Officer Gaddis 12-years, Officer Figg 5-years, Officer Blodgett 4-years and PSO Kinney 3-years.

FACILITIES/EQUIPMENT:

- The new 2013 Dodge Durango has been equipped and is on the road as a new patrol vehicle.
- Three Police Services officers have been hired and are scheduled to start on February 1. Equipment and uniforms have been ordered to outfit these new officers. There is one open position yet to be filled.

VOLUNTEERS:

- For the month, CRIME WATCH members volunteered a total of 96.75 hours of service, which included residence and business checks.
- For the month, the Hoquiam Police Explorer Post logged a total of 190 hours, which was a combination of patrolling with officers and meetings.

STATISTICAL REPORTS:

The following statistical reports encompass police activity for the month. The first statistical report titled "Law Incident Analysis, Time Reported" is a summary of each law incident by the day of the week and by the time of day.

The second statistical report is a listing of "Law Total Incident Report, by Location Code". The three general areas of the city are designated by location codes: HPD Baker 6 is defined as the east end, HPD Baker 7 is the downtown area and west to the high school, and HPD Baker 8 is the north end of town from Emerson Avenue. Any location codes that are outside of the city were likely generated as a result of phone call requests to the station, traffic safety patrols or agency assists.

The third statistical report, "Total Law Incident Report, by Nature of Incident" shows the total for each of the basic law incident types handled by the department.

The final two monthly reports included in this packet are "Total Traffic Citation Report, by Violation" and "Total Offense Report, By Statute Description". The first report lists the specific infraction or criminal charge and the number of violations issued under that charge. The second report is reflective of the number of "arrests" made under each statute. The two reports may overlap on some misdemeanor offenses if an arrest/booking was made followed by the issuance of a criminal citation. The second report captures felony arrests, but may not include misdemeanor or felony cases that were submitted to the prosecutor for review of charges (cases cleared without an arrest).
