

MONTHLY REPORT for February 2014

POLICE ACTIVITY:

- The department handled 1169 law incidents for the month, issued 57 infractions, 23 criminal traffic citations, 14 criminal citations, 13 parking infractions and made 78 criminal arrests.
- During the month, Animal Control Officer Bob Hill handled 78 "animal problem" complaints, 30 abandoned vehicles, 7 code enforcement issues and 33 parking complaints; 13 animals were impounded.
- **On 02-13-14** at about 1943 hours, officers were dispatched to a drive-in restaurant in the 100 block of Lincoln Street for a report of a vehicle versus building accident. During the investigation it was determined a 45-year old woman had struck the building while she attempted to park her vehicle. The woman who was determined to have been drinking said she "just wanted a burger". The woman was booked into the City Jail for DUI. The woman was not injured as a result of the accident and the building sustained moderate damage.
- **On 02-21-14** at about 2103 hours, officers were dispatched to the 400 block of Perry Avenue for report of shots being fired. Officers contacted the victim, a 29-year old Hoquiam man, who said he had been in a verbal dispute with his neighbor who lives in the 400 block of Queen Avenue. The man said his neighbor had pulled out a shotgun and fired at him. Officers are familiar with the suspect, a 37-year old Hoquiam man, from many prior contacts. Officers tried using the PA system on a police vehicle to hail the suspect but this was unsuccessful. It was determined a perimeter would be set up around the residence and the Critical Response Unit would be called for entry into the residence. The next morning entry was made but the suspect was not located. The suspect was later located in a garage next to his residence and booked into the county jail for Assault 2nd degree, Felon in Possession of Firearm and Illegal Firearm.
- **On 02-25-14** at about 1243 hours, officers were dispatched to a suicide call at a residence in the 2700 block of Cherry Street. Through the investigation it was found a 38-year old Hoquiam female had taken her own life by hanging herself with a piece of rope. Through interviews it was found the female had been drinking and very upset with her life.
- **On 02-26-14** at about 1244 hours, officers were dispatched to a residence in the 400 block of Perry Avenue for a possible domestic violence assault. During the investigation a 29-year old Hoquiam man was interviewed about the assault. During the interview Sgt. Dayton noticed the butt of a rifle sticking out of the mattress of the man's bed. When asked about the rifle the man said he had placed it there for protection after his neighbor had shot at him (HPD case #14-H02083) The man admitted he was a convicted felon. The man was arrested and taken into custody on a HMC warrant and transported to HPD. Sgt. Dayton applied for a search warrant to retrieve the weapon which was located and seized. The man will be charged not only for the warrant but for Felon in Possession of a Firearm and Assault.

- **On 02-26-14** at about 1000 hours, Sgt. Krohn and Aberdeen Detective Weiss traveled to Blythe California and took custody of a 31-year old Hoquiam man who had been serving a sentence at the Wallachuck Prison. The man was extradited back to Grays Harbor County to face charges of Robbery at the Twin Star Credit Union in Hoquiam and a Robbery charge in Aberdeen.

BUDGET:

- For the month, **326** of overtime was expended for patrol as listed below:

PERSONNEL:

- On February 13th Sgt. Krohn and Det. Blundred attended an 8-hour course on Sex Offenders: What Criminal Justice Professional and Child Advocates Should Know. This training was held in Montesano and instructed by Mental Health Professional Cory Jensen from Oregon.
- On February 18th Michael Roberts and Tyler Wright were hired to fill two Police Service Officer positions. Since this time they have been receiving training at the department to bring them up to speed with department procedures and the duties of their position. They will be attending the Corrections Officer Academy starting March 17th.
- Officers received re-certification baton training and defensive tactics this month which was held at HPD. The training was conducted on two days so both patrol teams could attend.
- On February 25th both PSO Roberts and Tyler were certified as Access Level II to enter warrants and restraining orders into the state computer which is part of their duties as Police Service Officers. This training was conducted by the Washington State Patrol.
- Officer Blodgett attended the Force Science Institute. This was a 40-hour course which is in-depth training in Use of Force issues and legal updates.
- Officer High has been with the department for 4-years and PSO Spaur celebrates one-year with department.

FACILITY:

- The department has billed the Department of Corrections \$31,888 for 384 bed days for DOC inmates housed in the City Jail for the month of February.

VOLUNTEERS:

- For the month, CRIME WATCH members volunteered a total of 48.5 hours of service, which included residence and business checks.

STATISTICAL REPORTS:

The following statistical reports encompass police activity for the month. The first statistical report titled "Law Incident Analysis, Time Reported" is a summary of each law incident by the day of the week and by the time of day.

The second statistical report is a listing of "Law Total Incident Report, by Location Code". The three general areas of the city are designated by location codes: HPD Baker 6 is defined as the east end, HPD Baker 7 is the downtown area and west to the high school, and HPD Baker 8 is the north end of town from Emerson Avenue. Any location codes that are outside of the city were likely generated as a result of phone call requests to the station, traffic safety patrols or agency assists.

The third statistical report, "Total Law Incident Report, by Nature of Incident" shows the total for each of the basic law incident types handled by the department.

The final two monthly reports included in this packet are "Total Traffic Citation Report, by Violation" and "Total Offense Report, By Statute Description". The first report lists the specific infraction or criminal charge and the number of violations issued under that charge. The second report is reflective of the number of "arrests" made under each statute. The two reports may overlap on some misdemeanor offenses if an arrest/booking was made followed by the issuance of a criminal citation. The second report captures felony arrests, but may not include misdemeanor or felony cases that were submitted to the prosecutor for review of charges (cases cleared without an arrest).
