MONTHLY REPORT for MARCH 2014

POLICE ACTIVITY:

- The department handled 1286 law incidents for the month, issued 75 infractions, 27 criminal traffic citations, 26 criminal citations, 33 parking infractions and made 75 criminal arrests.
- During the month, Animal Control Officer Bob Hill handled 51 “animal problem” complaints, 27 abandoned vehicles, 6 code enforcement issues and 44 parking complaints; 13 animals were impounded.
- **On 03-12-14** at about 0142 hours, officers were dispatched to a business in the 700 block of J Street for a report of a male subject causing a disturbance, trying to fight everyone in the bar. Officers arrived and saw two male subjects kicking a third male who was on the ground. The two males fled when they saw the police. One male was located hiding behind a car and attempted to fight with the officers as they were taking him into custody. Officers told him he would be tased if he did not comply. The victim and second assailant had fled while officers dealt with the first subject and were not identified. The 20-year old Hoquiam man was booked into the City Jail for Disorderly Conduct, Minor Frequenting a Tavern, Resisting Arrest and making False or Misleading Statements to Public Servant.
- **On 03-14-14** at about 2213 hours, officers were watching a residence in the 2400 block of Simpson Avenue which is known for the sale of illegal drugs. They saw a male and female leave the residence and recognized the male as a 29-year old Hoquiam man, who is a known heroin user and had an Aberdeen warrant for his arrest. Officers set up in the area and watched as the male and female entered a business in the 2500 block of Simpson Avenue. As the subjects left the business the male saw the police and fled on foot. A short foot pursuit followed and the male was taken into custody as he attempted to jump a fence. The female was identified as the suspect’s wife who has a No-Contact Order with the male. The suspect was booked into the City Jail for Violation of a Court Order.
- **On 03-20-14** at about 0403 hours, officers were dispatched to the 2500 block of Aberdeen Avenue for a report of an older male subject prowling vehicles in the area. Officers found a 44-year old Aberdeen transient sitting inside a jeep. The male was asked if the jeep belonged to him and he replied no. The owner of the jeep was contacted and confirmed he did not know the man and had not given him permission to be in his vehicle. The male was taken into custody. During a pat down search suspected methamphetamine was located in his jacket pocket. The suspect was booked into the City Jail for vehicle Prowl 2nd degree and Attempted Theft. Once the suspected narcotics are verified by the State Crime Lab he will be charged with Possession of Illegal Narcotics. The next day the suspect was connected to a Vehicle Prowl in the 2400 block of Aberdeen where a car stereo was taken. He will be charged with another charge of Vehicle Prowl 2nd degree and Theft.
- **On 03-21-14** at about 0021 hours, officers were dispatched to an assault complaint in the 300 block of Eklund Avenue. During the investigation it was discovered a 28-year old Aberdeen

man had entered the residence of a 26-year old Hoquiam man and struck him several times with some type of metal club. Both subjects are well known to officers as being thieves and drug abusers. At this time it is unknown at this time if the assault was over illegal drugs. The victim sustained a fractured left hand and minor wounds to his head. The victim was uncooperative during the investigation and refused medical attention. The suspect has not been located and the case has been forwarded to the County Prosecutor for review and filing on the charge of Assault in the 2nd Degree.

- **On 03-21-14** at about 2103 hours, officers were dispatched to an apartment complex in the 600 block of 7th Street for a disturbance complaint. It was discovered a 39-year old Hoquiam man in one of the apartments was yelling and screaming obscenities which could be clearly heard around the complex. Officers went to the door which was opened by the man. The man immediately accused the officers of stealing his vehicle and then started poking the officer in the chest. The man was told he was under arrest for assault and immediately started to resist arrest. The man was taken into custody after a short struggle and booked into the City Jail for Resisting Arrest, Assault 4th Degree and Disorderly House. It was obvious the man was suffering from mental health issues and MHP was contacted to evaluate these issues.

PERSONNEL:

- On March 6th the department took part in a multi-agency Active-Shooter drill, which was held in the 600 block of 30th Street in a vacant building. The drill was designed to see how different agencies would work together in this type of scenario. Agencies involved with the drill were the Aberdeen and Hoquiam Police Departments, Aberdeen and Hoquiam Fire Departments and the Crisis Response Unit.
- Officers went through firearms training this month. Officers qualified with service pistols, rifles and back-up/off duty weapons. The training was held on two separate dates so both teams could attend.
- Police Services Officers Wright and Roberts started the Corrections Officers Academy on March 17th and will graduate on April 11th. Once they graduate and get familiar with their duties at the department they will be placed with a patrol squad as will the other two PSO's.
- Two department members are celebrating anniversaries this month; Sgt. Krohn 25 years and Officer Pearson 2 years.

CITY JAIL:

- The department has billed the Department of Corrections for 490 bed days in the amount of \$40,376 for DOC inmates housed in the City Jail for the month of March.
- The department has nearly expended its funds for outside placement of inmates. Sometimes this is a necessary cost which is needed for long term commitment sentences ordered by the Hoquiam Municipal Court

VOLUNTEERS:

- For the month, CRIME WATCH members volunteered a total 116 of hours of service, which included residence and business checks. This month CRIME WATCH volunteer Karen Harp lost her son Jay to cancer. Our condolences go out to her for her loss.

STATISTICAL REPORTS:

The following statistical reports encompass police activity for the month. The first statistical report titled "Law Incident Analysis, Time Reported" is a summary of each law incident by the day of the week and by the time of day.

The second statistical report is a listing of "Law Total Incident Report, by Location Code". The three general areas of the city are designated by location codes: HPD Baker 6 is defined as the east end, HPD Baker 7 is the downtown area and west to the high school, and HPD Baker 8 is the north end of town from Emerson Avenue. Any location codes that are outside of the city were likely generated as a result of phone call requests to the station, traffic safety patrols or agency assists.

The third statistical report, "Total Law Incident Report, by Nature of Incident" shows the total for each of the basic law incident types handled by the department.

The final two monthly reports included in this packet are "Total Traffic Citation Report, by Violation" and "Total Offense Report, By Statute Description". The first report lists the specific infraction or criminal charge and the number of violations issued under that charge. The second report is reflective of the number of "arrests" made under each statute. The two reports may overlap on some misdemeanor offenses if an arrest/booking was made followed by the issuance of a criminal citation. The second report captures felony arrests, but may not include misdemeanor or felony cases that were submitted to the prosecutor for review of charges (cases cleared without an arrest).
