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## *MONTHLY REPORT for APRIL 2014*

### POLICE ACTIVITY:

- The department handled 1180 law incidents for the month, issued 65 infractions, 29 criminal traffic citations, 19 criminal citations, 10 parking infractions and made 89 criminal arrests.
- During the month, Animal Control Officer Bob Hill handled 56 “animal problem” complaints, 23 abandoned vehicles, 4 code enforcement issues and 39 parking complaints; 12 animals were impounded.
- **On 04-07-14** at about 1619 hours, officers were dispatched to a business in the 200 block of Lincoln Street reference a Vehicle Prowl complaint. As someone had crawled through an open sun roof of a vehicle to steal a purse which contained a pistol. Officers were able to view security footage showing the parking lot. Two suspects were identified who are well known to be extremely active in the illegal drug culture and thieves. The investigation developed witnesses who verified the suspects as 26-year old and 29-year old Hoquiam men. The suspects were located and arrested; both admitted to the Vehicle Prowl. The 26-year old man was booked into the City Jail for Theft 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree, the 29-year old was booked into the County Jail for Unlawful Possession of a Firearm 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree and Possession of a Stolen Firearm. As he cannot legally own a firearm.
- **On 04-16-14** at about 1402 hours, officers were dispatched to a residence in the 800 block of Rayonier Avenue reference an intruder call. Officers have responded to the residence many times too deal with a 46-year old Hoquiam woman who suffers from mental illness. Officers saw the female with a knife in her hand chasing her elderly father threatening to stab him. Sgt. Salstrom drew his department taser and ordered her to drop the knife. The female complied and was taken to the hospital for a mental health evaluation; she also faces charges of DVA 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Assault.
- **On 04-20-14** at about 0519 hours, officers responded to a residence in the 300 block of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street for a Burglary complaint. The victim, a 39-year old Hoquiam woman reported her ex-fiancé and his mother broke into the house through the front door and assaulted her and her friend. The victim showed signs of being assaulted and the front door jamb was shattered. The victim stated her 29-year old ex-fiancé and his 50-year old mother live in Elma. An attempt to locate was broadcast but the suspects have not been located. The case has been submitted on both for DVA Burglary, Assault 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree and Malicious Mischief.
- **On 04-23-14** at about 1608 hours, officers were dispatched to the alley behind a business in the 3000 block of Simpson Avenue for a report of a Robbery which had just occurred. The victim, a 47-year old Hoquiam woman, said she had been walking in the alley when a male on a bicycle rode up from behind her, grabbed her purse and then rode off. She said he was last seen turning south onto 31<sup>st</sup> Street from the alley. An extensive search for the suspect by both HPD and APD produced negative results. At this time the suspect is at large and has not been

identified. However the suspect is likely linked to a suspected drug house in the area which officers have been targeting.

- For the month, **433 hours** of overtime was expended for patrol as listed below:

#### PERSONNEL:

- Sgt. Salstrom attended a 40-hour training course on Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training. This training covered Terrorism Response Training: Active Shooter Train-the-Trainer. The training was held at the old Maple Lane School in Rochester and hosted by CJTC and the U.S. Attorney General's office. The training taught movements and tactics in dealing with active-shooters.
- During the last part of April and (into May) department members are attending Active-Shooter training. Sgt. Salstrom used the information and training he learned to instruct officers on movements and tactics to find and stop an active-shooter in several different circumstances. The training is being held on different dates so both patrol teams could attend.
- Police Services Officers Tyler Wright and Michael Roberts graduated from the Corrections Officer Academy on April 11<sup>th</sup>. PSO Wright and Roberts were introduced and sworn in on April 28<sup>th</sup> during the City Council meeting.
- The four Police Services Officers have been placed on patrol squads and now work the same three day on- three day off work schedule. This way each PSO will work closely with a patrol squad and have a direct supervisor.
- Officers went through annual qualifications with duty pistols, rifles and off duty weapons. This training was held on two different dates so both patrol teams could attend.
- Two officers celebrate anniversaries this month with the department, Officer Hergert 8-years and Officer McCartney 5-years.
- On April 26<sup>th</sup> Officer Gaddis, our evidence custodian, manned the department lobby for the DEA Drug Take Back Day. During the four hours 98 citizens dropped off unwanted medications. A total of 312 pounds of medications were collected; the medications filled eight large boxes and were shipped off to the DEA for incineration.

#### CITY JAIL:

- The department billed DOC for 427 bed days in the amount of \$35,184 for the month of April.
- For the 2013-2014 budgeted, Chief Myers estimated revenue of \$300,000 through the DOC contract. Our first full year of operation actually yielded \$385,451 due to the demand for DOC beds beyond projection. At this rate, revenue from the state contract offsets **76.6%** of our City Jail budget! The City Jail is not a "money maker" and was not intended to be. However, with this innovative partnership with the state has allowed the City of Hoquiam to reopen and operate the City Jail fulfilling an important Hometown Hoquiam goal- for only 23 cents on the

dollar. We believe our City Jail improves public safety not only within Hoquiam, but all communities of Grays Harbor. It is hard to imagine where we would be in our Hometown Hoquiam plan without the City Jail and the stability and security it provides every day on our streets.

#### VOLUNTEERS:

- For the month, CRIME WATCH members volunteered a total 111.75 of hours of service, which included residence and business checks. During the City Council meeting on April 14<sup>th</sup> the department volunteers were presented and introduced; present was the department Chaplain, Crime Watch and members of the Police Explorer Post. This was for recognition for Volunteer Appreciation Week. They are a very dedicated group of people who donate their time to the department and citizens of Hoquiam.

#### STATISTICAL REPORTS:

The following statistical reports encompass police activity for the month. The first statistical report titled "Law Incident Analysis, Time Reported" is a summary of each law incident by the day of the week and by the time of day.

The second statistical report is a listing of "Law Total Incident Report, by Location Code". The three general areas of the city are designated by location codes: HPD Baker 6 is defined as the east end, HPD Baker 7 is the downtown area and west to the high school, and HPD Baker 8 is the north end of town from Emerson Avenue. Any location codes that are outside of the city were likely generated as a result of phone call requests to the station, traffic safety patrols or agency assists.

The third statistical report, "Total Law Incident Report, by Nature of Incident" shows the total for each of the basic law incident types handled by the department.

The final two monthly reports included in this packet are "Total Traffic Citation Report, by Violation" and "Total Offense Report, By Statute Description". The first report lists the specific infraction or criminal charge and the number of violations issued under that charge. The second report is reflective of the number of "arrests" made under each statute. The two reports may overlap on some misdemeanor offenses if an arrest/booking was made followed by the issuance of a criminal citation. The second report captures felony arrests, but may not include misdemeanor or felony cases that were submitted to the prosecutor for review of charges (cases cleared without an arrest).
