## *MONTHLY REPORT for December 2015*

### POLICE ACTIVITY:

- The department handled 1096 law incidents for the month, issued 46 infractions, 31 criminal traffic citations, 35 criminal citations, 47 parking infractions and made 60 criminal arrests.
- During the month, Animal Control Officer Tom Taylor handled 31 “animal problem” complaints, 12 abandoned vehicles, and 64 parking complaints; 11 animals were impounded.
- **On 12-05-15** at about 2330 hours, officers stopped a 47-year old Hoquiam woman for driving the wrong way in the 200 block of 6<sup>th</sup> Street. The woman didn't stop her vehicle until she got onto the Riverside Bridge. She exited her vehicle and climbed over the railing threatening to jump off the bridge. Officers were able to distract her as another officer was able to get behind her and pull her back over the railing. The female was arrested for DUI and booked into the City Jail. Before the woman was released she was evaluated at the City Jail by a Mental Health Professional.
- **On 12-14-15** at about 0030 hours, Officer Spaur attempted to pull over a vehicle for a headlight violation in the 300 block of Myrtle Street. As the officer was exiting his patrol car the driver sped off; which lead to a short pursuit into Aberdeen. The driver abandoned the vehicle leaving behind his passenger. The passenger identified the driver as a 36-year old Hoquiam man. A search of the area was conducted but the suspect was not located. During the search for the suspect, a female called 911 to report her vehicle stolen about 20-minutes prior to her calling. Coincidentally the female was the girlfriend of the suspect driver, but she wanted to make it clear the driver was not her boyfriend. The suspect was arrested the next day at his residence in the 2800 block of Aberdeen Avenue.
- **On 12-15-15** at about 1100 hours, officers received information through the Cosmopolis Police Department that a 42-year old Aberdeen man was going to try and commit a Robbery at a bank in the 600 block of Simpson Avenue. The suspect was in contact by social media saying he was right across the street from the bank. Officers responded to the area and began to search for the suspect. At about 1130 hours officers received information the suspect was at the Hoquiam Library. The suspect was arrested as he attempted to flee the area on foot. The suspect was booked into the County Jail for Attempted Robbery and will ultimately be extradited to Colorado on an unrelated crime.
- **On 12-15-15** at about 1210 hours, officers responded to a disturbance at a residence in the 2400 block of Sumner Avenue. Officers arrived and contacted a 39-year old female and her 44-year old boyfriend. The male had a large bleeding cut on the bridge of his nose. The female suspect tried to explain they had been in an argument and she had swung a paint can at her boyfriend to keep him away from her; she said she didn't mean to hit him. PSO Martinez was brought to the scene to interpret for the Hispanic male. He explained his girlfriend was upset that he had taken her bike to fix it and an argument ensued resulting in her hitting him with a paint can. The

female was booked into the City Jail for Simple Assault DVA. The victim did not need medical attention.

- **On 12-19-15** at about 2008 hours, officers responded to a residence in the 400 block of Eklund Avenue for a reported suicide attempt. It was reported a 51-year old Hoquiam man had cut his wrists and was being combative with family members. Officers found the man sitting in a pool of blood in the bath tub. The officers tried to talk with the man but he just tried to force the wounds open more and yell at the officers. The officers had to physically restrain him so he could be treated by HFD paramedics and transported to the hospital. Upon arrival at the hospital it took a combination of 7 officers and hospital staff to control him for treatment. The man was treated for his wounds and was scheduled to be evaluated by MHP.
- **For 2015**, the department the handled a total of **14,622** law incidents.

#### PERSONNEL:

- Department members participated once again in this year's Shop with a Cop event held on December 5<sup>th</sup>. This is always a fun event and the children who participate are very appreciative of the \$100.00 gift card they get to spend on anything they wish. The gift cards are donated by local sponsors and Wal-Mart with the breakfast hosted by the Aberdeen Eagles.
- Sean Hollen the department Chaplain has been with the department for 9-years. He has been a valued volunteer with the department. He was always willing and available to assist the citizens of Hoquiam during times of crisis.
- Several department members were re-certified with impact weapons on December 15<sup>th</sup>. This was a make-up class for department members who were excused from the November training. The training was held in the department training room and conducted by our Defensive Tactics Instructor David Blundred.
- Once Sgt. Dayton was cleared for light duty after an off-duty injury and surgery he was placed in Investigations. Det. Blundred was assigned as Acting Sergeant for Sgt. Dayton's patrol squad. This is a great opportunity for both as they get to see what it takes to supervise within different divisions in the department.

#### FACILITY:

- The department billed DOC for 535 bed days in the amount of \$45,475.00 for the month of December.
- The department billed the Ocean Shores Police Department for 13 bed days in the amount of \$1,071.20 for the month of December.
- The department billed the Cosmopolis Police Department for 7 bed days in the amount of \$595.00 for the months of November and December.
- The construction of the new jail addition is coming along very well. I have talked with the project manager and he estimates the project should be completed by the middle of February.

#### VOLUNTEERS:

- For the month of December, CRIME WATCH members volunteered a total of **55.25 hours** of service, which included residence and business checks. CRIME WATCH members also participated in the Shop with a Cop program, Montesano's Festival of Lights and Ho Ho Hoquiam.
- In 2015, the Crime Watch Volunteers donated a total of **1,116.25 hours** of service to the City of Hoquiam. These hours not only covered events and residence/business checks in Hoquiam but also community functions throughout Grays Harbor County. All of the Crime Watch Volunteers should be commended for their time and service to our community.
- For the month, the Hoquiam Police Explorer Post logged a total of **154.5 hours**, which was a combination of patrolling with officers and meetings. Members of the Police Explorer Post also participated in the Shop with a Cop program and were actors in a recent Grays Harbor County Active Shooter Drill.

#### STATISTICAL REPORTS:

The following statistical reports encompass police activity for the month. The first statistical report titled "Law Incident Analysis, Time Reported" is a summary of each law incident by the day of the week and by the time of day.

The second statistical report is a listing of "Law Total Incident Report, by Location Code". The three general areas of the city are designated by location codes: HPD Baker 6 is defined as the east end, HPD Baker 7 is the downtown area and west to the high school, and HPD Baker 8 is the north end of town from Emerson Avenue. Any location codes that are outside of the city were likely generated as a result of phone call requests to the station, traffic safety patrols or agency assists.

The third statistical report, "Total Law Incident Report, by Nature of Incident" shows the total for each of the basic law incident types handled by the department.

The final two monthly reports included in this packet are "Total Traffic Citation Report, by Violation" and "Total Offense Report, By Statute Description". The first report lists the specific infraction or criminal charge and the number of violations issued under that charge. The second report is reflective of the number of "arrests" made under each statute. The two reports may overlap on some misdemeanor offenses if an arrest/booking was made followed by the issuance of a criminal citation. The second report captures felony arrests, but may not include misdemeanor or felony cases which were submitted to the prosecutor for review of charges (cases cleared without an arrest).
