

MONTHLY REPORT for September 2015

POLICE ACTIVITY:

- The department handled 1267 law incidents for the month, issued 118 infractions, 34 criminal traffic citations, 23 criminal citations, 6 parking infractions and made 61 criminal arrests.
- **On 09-16-15** at about 1135 hours, officers received information from dispatch, a citizen was following a red Honda car on Lincoln Street which was reported as stolen from Aberdeen. The vehicle plate was checked and it was indeed reported as stolen. The citizen, a 22-year old Aberdeen woman, was reporting she was behind the vehicle and said it belonged to her brother in-law. Officers set up for it as it was believed the vehicle was heading for the bridge detour. A short pursuit began on Levee Street and 6th Street, with the vehicle striking road closure signs. The pursuit continued into the traffic revision on Riverside. Chief Myers ordered the pursuit to be terminated as the driver had been identified. This didn't slow the suspect who collided with a vehicle on Sumner Avenue, (which turned out to be the original reporting party). The suspect then fled on foot after crashing into a yard in the 2200 block of Sumner. The suspect, a 36-year old Aberdeen man, was located hiding under a trailer in a driveway in the 2500 block of Aberdeen Avenue. He was taken into custody for Felony Eluding, Possession of Stolen Vehicle and Hit and Run Attended. He was booked into the County Jail after being treated for minor injuries from the crash. The female in the vehicle he struck was taken to the hospital as a precaution as she is pregnant; she was later released and returned the scene.
- **On 09-16-15** at about 2339 hours, officers were dispatched to an unknown injury accident at Bay Avenue and 28th Street. It was reported a black vehicle had struck a parked semi-trailer. It was also reported two males had ran from the vehicle and there was one trapped in the back seat who was un-responsive. Aberdeen Officers also responded and located two males in the 2900 block of Pacific Avenue. One subject, a 21- year old Aberdeen man, dropped the keys to the vehicle when he was contacted. The other male, a 17-year old Aberdeen male juvenile, was transported to the hospital for minor injuries. The 3rd male trapped in the car, was identified as an 18-year old Aberdeen man, died from injuries sustained in the accident. The 21-year old Aberdeen man was arrested on a DOC warrant and booked into the City Jail. The collision scene was mapped by the Hoquiam Total Station Team and investigated by Hoquiam Detectives. The suspect is currently in the County Jail on Vehicular Homicide, Vehicular Assault, Felony Hit and Run and Driving Under the Influence charges.
- **On 09-19-15** at about 0531 hours, officers were dispatched to the Simpson Bridge where a 70-year old woman was found trapped in the safety netting under the bridge construction area. Apparently the woman had been in the safety netting for several hours and was discovered yelling for help by the bridge tender. Apparently the woman had walked up the bridge, intoxicated; disregarding the closure signs and fell into the safety netting. The woman was

transported to the hospital to be checked out. A Trespassing charge will be submitted to the City Prosecutor for review.

- **On 09-20-15** at about 2019 hours, officers dispatched to a residence in the 2200 block of Sumner. The 63-year old Hoquiam woman said someone was on her property and when she looked outside she saw it was a 62-year old Centralia man she has a Protection Order against. The suspect had previously been convicted in Grays Harbor for Stalking the same person. She told the officers as she did in the past she has never neither had an intimate relationship with the suspect nor even dated him; they were only neighbors in the past. The suspect was located in his vehicle about a block away and taken into custody for violating the order. The suspect was booked into the County on a Stalking charge.
- **On 09-30-15**, the Grays Harbor Drug Task Force, DEA, FBI and members of the Hoquiam Police Department, Aberdeen Police Department, Grays Harbor Sheriff's Department, Washington State Patrol and members of the Lewis County CRU Team conducted search warrants on 11 locations throughout Grays Harbor. The Grays Harbor Drug Task Force and DEA had worked together on a two-year investigation involving the distribution of Heroin, Methamphetamine and Cocaine by a Hispanic group in the area. In all over 100 Law Enforcement Officers were involved with the operation which resulted in the arrest of several suspects and the recovery of drugs, vehicles, money and a gun. The Drug Task Force and DEA worked many long hours on this operation and should be commended for such a successful outcome.

PERSONNEL:

- On 09-12-15 Hoquiam officers, Crime Watch Volunteers and Police Explorer members helped with traffic control during this year's Logger's Play day.
- During Logger's Play Day, the department Explorer Post had their own booth along 7th Street. The members were able to share with citizens just what they did in the program and also sought out prospective applicants for the program.
- The final process and testing has been completed for Jesus Martinez to fill the last slot for Police Services Officer. He will be starting on October 5th to begin his training. He will be doing on the job training with the other Police Services Officers. An application for Martinez has been submitted for him to attend the January 2016 Correction Officers Academy.

- On 09-14-15 Det. Blundred instructed a class on Excited Delirium for the Crime Watch Volunteers. This was a very good class and the information was greatly appreciated by those who attended.
- Officer Luce celebrated 7-years with department this month. Along with his patrol duties he also a Bicycle patrol Officer and the department's Gang Liaison. He is also the co-leader of the department's Explorer Program along with Officer Peterson.

FACILITY:

- The department billed the Department of Corrections for 610 bed days for a total of \$51,850.00.
- The department billed the Ocean Shores Police Department for 8 bed days in the amount of \$659.20.

VOLUNTEERS:

- For the month, CRIME WATCH members volunteered a total of 143.5 hours of service, which included residence and business checks. Crime Watch also assisted with traffic control on Logger's Play Day and provided security during High School football games.

STATISTICAL REPORTS:

The following statistical reports encompass police activity for the month. The first statistical report titled "Law Incident Analysis, Time Reported" is a summary of each law incident by the day of the week and by the time of day.

The second statistical report is a listing of "Law Total Incident Report, by Location Code". The three general areas of the city are designated by location codes: HPD Baker 6 is defined as the east end, HPD Baker 7 is the downtown area and west to the high school, and HPD Baker 8 is the north end of town from Emerson Avenue. Any location codes that are outside of the city were likely generated as a result of phone call requests to the station, traffic safety patrols or agency assists.

The third statistical report, "Total Law Incident Report, by Nature of Incident" shows the total for each of the basic law incident types handled by the department.

The final two monthly reports included in this packet are "Total Traffic Citation Report, by Violation" and "Total Offense Report, By Statute Description". The first report lists the specific infraction or criminal charge and the number of violations issued under that charge. The second report is reflective of the number of "arrests" made under each statute. The two reports may overlap on some misdemeanor offenses if an arrest/booking was made followed by the issuance of a criminal citation. The second report captures felony arrests, but may not include misdemeanor or felony cases which were submitted to the prosecutor for review of charges (cases cleared without an arrest).
