

## MONTHLY REPORT for FEBRUARY 2016

### POLICE ACTIVITY:

- The department handled 1223 law incidents for the month, issued 101 infractions, 29 criminal traffic citations, 18 criminal citations, 43 parking infractions and made 98 criminal arrests.
- During the month, Animal Control Officer Tom Taylor handled 21 “animal problem” complaints, 17 abandoned vehicles, 1 code enforcement issue and 101 parking complaints; 13 animals were impounded.
- **On 02-07-16** at about 0514 hours, officers were dispatched to an alarm call at the Hoquiam Post Office. Officers arrived and contacted a 19-year old woman and 34-year old man, both from the Ocean Shores area. The couple said they were only in the lobby to stay warm. The couple were identified and released as no sign of crime was located at that time. Before officers cleared from the scene Sgt. Salstrom located small brass screws on the floor near some mail boxes. It was discovered a large mail box had been tampered with and could be slid out gaining access to the secure part of the Post Office. The couple was re-contacted a short time later and found to be in possession of Post Office property in their back packs. Both suspects were booked into the County Jail for Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree. Two Postal Inspectors have been assigned the case; the two suspects could now face Federal charges.
- **On 02-23-16** at about 1122 hours, officers were dispatched to a residence in the 400 block of Eklund Avenue for a reported stabbing. It was reported the suspect and victim were still on scene. Officers arrived and located the victim, a 31-year old Hoquiam man, on the porch bleeding heavily from a wound to his arm. The suspect, a 40-year old Hoquiam man, was standing at an open upstairs window still armed with the knife. The suspect was ordered to drop the knife to the ground, which he did, and remain where he could be seen. The man complied and was taken into custody without any other incidents. The investigation revealed the two men were roommates. Apparently the suspect had disrespected the victim and was told to move out. The two started fighting and the suspect stabbed his roommate in the arm. The suspect was booked into the county jail for DV Assault 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree. The victim was treated at the hospital and released.
- **On 02-24-16** at about 1530 hours, a 22-year old Aberdeen woman came to the police department for visitation of an inmate. She was told she could leave her purse in her vehicle before entering the department or it was subject to a search before entry was made. The female said she didn't have a vehicle and said she needed to use the restroom first. She was in the restroom for quite a while. When she was allowed in for visitation nothing illegal was found in her purse. The lobby restroom was checked by officers as it was believed she may have hidden illegal items. The search resulted in empty drug wrappers and drug paraphernalia being located in the trash can. As the woman was leaving she was contacted and confronted with what was located. The woman confessed she indeed hid the drug wrappers and other items before the

visitation, as she did not want to get into trouble. The woman was cited for Possession of drug paraphernalia and released.

- **On 02-24-16** at about 1642 hours, officers were dispatched to an apartment complex in the 500 block of Emerson Avenue. It was reported a male was assaulting a female inside a vehicle in front of the building. An officer arrived and found a 32-year old Aberdeen man, was actively assaulting a 25-year old Hoquiam woman. The man was yelling at the woman, who was screaming for help; he was striking her repeatedly. The man was pulled off the woman and, with the threat of being Tased he was taken into custody. The suspect was booked into the City jail for DVA Assault 4<sup>th</sup> Degree. Despite the traumatic event, the woman refused aid or to make a statement against her boyfriend.
- **On 02-26-16** at about 2122 hours, Hoquiam Officers assisted APD with a disorderly subject call at a business in the 1800 block of Simpson Avenue in Aberdeen. It was reported a male subject had entered the business and ordered everything off the menu then walked behind the counter yelling at the employees. The male left the store last seen walking east on Simpson Avenue. Officers located the 21-year old Hoquiam man, and attempted to detain him for the investigation. The suspect became very belligerent saying "you're only doing this because I'm black" (he is a caucasian male). He was making other nonsense statements; it was obvious he was either under the influence of some type of substance or having mental issues. The suspect attempted to leave and became combative. The suspect was taken to the ground and handcuffed. He was later transported to the hospital for mental treatment by an APD Officer.
- **On 02-27-16**, Acting Sergeant Blundred was honored this year as the Masonic Lodge Officer of the Year. Acting Sergeant Blundred was commended for his excellent work upon the conclusion of a four year assignment as a detective. Upon conclusion of this assignment he was assigned as an Acting Sergeant to supervise a patrol squad. Acting Sergeant Blundred is an excellent representative for the department and City of Hoquiam.

#### BUDGET:

- For the month, **140 hours** of overtime was expended for patrol as listed below:

#### PERSONNEL:

- Sgt. Salstrom attended a 2-day training for Instructor in Advanced Active Shooter Incidents. This training builds on Sgt. Salstrom's expertise in this area of Active Shooter Instructor for the department and other agencies in the area.
- Defensive Tactics training was held in the department's training room this month. The training was conducted by ASGT. Blundred. The training was held on two-separate days so both teams could attend.
- Officer Spaur has completed his probationary period of 1-year. He has shown that he has a good working knowledge of police work and is striving to better himself each and every day. He has proven to be a valued officer and an asset to the City of Hoquiam and its citizens.

- Three department members celebrated anniversaries with the department in February: Officer High 6-years, Officer Spaur 3-years, PSO Wright and PSO Roberts, both with 2-years.

#### FACILITY:

- The department billed the Department of Corrections \$55,335.00 for 651 bed days for DOC inmates housed in the City Jail during the month of February.
- Ocean Shores was billed for 8 bed days in the amount of \$659.20.
- The Cosmopolis Police Department was billed for 3 bed days in the amount of \$255.00.

#### VOLUNTEERS:

- For the month, CRIME WATCH members volunteered a total of 56.5 hours of service, which included residence and business checks.
- The Hoquiam Police Explorers logged 45 hours during the month. These hours were for meetings and riding with officers on patrol.

#### STATISTICAL REPORTS:

The following statistical reports encompass police activity for the month. The first statistical report titled "Law Incident Analysis, Time Reported" is a summary of each law incident by the day of the week and by the time of day.

The second statistical report is a listing of "Law Total Incident Report, by Location Code". The three general areas of the city are designated by location codes: HPD Baker 6 is defined as the east end, HPD Baker 7 is the downtown area and west to the high school, and HPD Baker 8 is the north end of town from Emerson Avenue. Any location codes that are outside of the city were likely generated as a result of phone call requests to the station, traffic safety patrols or agency assists.

The third statistical report, "Total Law Incident Report, by Nature of Incident" shows the total for each of the basic law incident types handled by the department.

The final two monthly reports included in this packet are "Total Traffic Citation Report, by Violation" and "Total Offense Report, By Statute Description". The first report lists the specific infraction or criminal charge and the number of violations issued under that charge. The second report is reflective of the number of "arrests" made under each statute. The two reports may overlap on some misdemeanor offenses if an arrest/booking was made followed by the issuance of a criminal citation. The second report captures felony arrests, but may not include misdemeanor or felony cases that were submitted to the prosecutor for review of charges (cases cleared without an arrest).
