

## CITY OF HOQUIAM

### EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDER

**WHEREAS**, on February 29, 2020, the Governor of the State of Washington proclaimed that a state of emergency exists in all counties in the State of Washington as a result of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 11, 2020, The World Health Organization declared that the spread of the COVID-19 virus had created a global pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 12, 2020, the Grays Harbor County Board of Commissioner declared an emergency regarding the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 13, 2020, an emergency was declared in the City of Hoquiam by executive order of the Mayor of Hoquiam; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governor of the State of Washington issued Proclamation 20-25, et seq., entitled *“Safe Start – Stay Healthy” County by County Phased Reopening*; and


**WHEREAS**, on November 16, 2020, the Governor of the State of Washington issued Proclamation 20-25-8, entitled *“Stay Safe – Stay Healthy” Rollback of County-by-County Phased Reopening Responding to a COVID-19 Outbreak Surge*; and

**WHEREAS**, Governor’s Proclamation 20-24-8 requires that the City of Hoquiam close City buildings to public access.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED BY** the Mayor of Hoquiam, Grays Harbor county, State of Washington, as follows:

Section 1. Effective November 16, 2020, at 5:00 p.m., Hoquiam City Hall, and other City buildings, shall be closed to public access until further notice. The lobby at the Hoquiam Police Station shall remain open during business hours with COVID-19 restrictions in place.
